

Juniors in Action

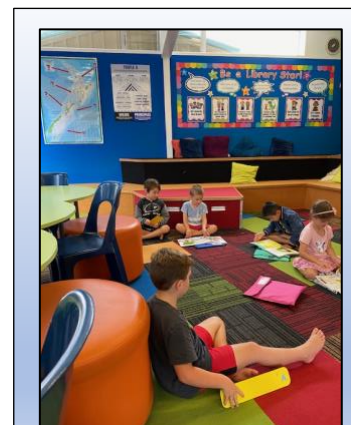
